TOYO-INDIA – CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) ACTIVITIES DURING 2019-20

Empowering the society is at the core of Toyo-India's CSR program. As a socially committed corporate, Toyo-India has contributed CSR funds in the areas of promoting education, promoting preventive health care and sanitation and disaster management including relief rehabilitation and reconstruction activities during the year 2019-20.

Education:

With a keen interest in promoting education in the rural parts of India, Toyo India made CSR contribution as under:

• Toyo India distributed 2 sets of school uniform to 240 boys and girl students of Adivasi High School, Walwanda, District Palghar and 686 boys and girl students of the Vidyamandir Gorhe in Wada Taluka, District Palghar. Toyo-India also distributed 2 sets of school uniform and footwear to 50 boys and girl students of the Anudanit Primary and Secondary Aashram School at Maan, Taluka – Vikramgadh, District – Palghar. These schools are remotely located in the backward areas, imparting education to the students from 5th to 10th standard. The students were very happy as they got new uniforms at the very beginning of the year.
















Toyo-India provided financial assistance to Nava Samaj Vidyamandir, Manivali, Post - Dugad, Taluka - Bhivandi, District - Thane towards construction of 4 classrooms alongwith with electrical fittings, fans, tube lights, benches, blackboards, tables and chairs, toilet blocks and Science Lab alongwith equipments. The earlier school building was in a dilapidated condition and was very dangerous to use.













• Under the "Happy Schools" Project, Toyo-India contributed for modernisation of 16 Government Primary and Junior High Schools in Gorakhpur near the HURL Project site by providing necessary infrastructure.

















- Toyo India also provided CSR funds to "Bhavani Vidyarthi Kalyan Pratishthan" Arvi,
 District Beed, Maharashtra for construction of girls` hostel under their Shantivan Project
 which aims at providing education and basic necessities to the children from the
 underprivileged sections of society.
- Contribution was also made for repairing, painting and tiling work of Shei Vibhag High School, Shei, Taluka – Shahpur, Dist – Thane. The said school building was in a dilapidated condition and needed urgent repairs. This project will provide and improve learning facilities for about 500 students.





• Contribution was also made for construction of main hall in new complex of Shantimandir at Ganeshpuri, Thane district. The said Hall will be used for various activities like Yoga, Sanskrit teaching, women empowerment activities etc.

Healthcare:

Toyo-India has undertaken various healthcare initiatives to provide medical services to the poor and needy people as under:

• On 16 January 2020, the Company handed over fully equipped Blood Donation Van to R.S.S. Jankalyan Samiti`s Kai. Wamanrao Oak Raktapedhi, Thane. It is a fully equipped, "State of the Art", FDA approved, and State Blood Transfusion Council (SBTC) registered Blood Bank, operational in and around Thane area since 2007 on a "Not for Profit" basis. They have been arranging camps in and around Thane, with an average collection of 4,000 blood bags annually. The Blood Donation Van will help them in reaching out to the blood donors in interior areas and increase blood donor base by about 20-25% (i.e. at least 1,000 donors each year).









 Contribution was also made for arranging 2 Dialysis machines to Shree Mahavir Jain Hospital, Thane. In the said Hospital, a Dialysis Centre comprising 14 dialysis machines has been set up with the aim of providing dialysis facilities at a very nominal cost to the poor and needy patients. At a function held on 10 September 2019, the Dialysis Centre was inaugurated when two Dialysis machines arranged through our CSR contribution were handed over to the said Hospital.





 Toyo-India has also provided CSR funds for arranging Dura Diagnost machine and Premium Ultrasound Color Doppler Machine for Radiology at "Guru Shri Gorakshnath Chikitsalay" a charitable Hospital at Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh near HURL site. The said hospital runs on no profit basis and it is run by an NGO headed by Yogi Adityanath, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh.

Disaster Management:

Toyo-India extended its helping hand by contributing to the "Chief Minister's Relief Fund" towards the disaster management for relief and rehabilitation work undertaken in the flood ravaged districts in Western Maharashtra's Sangli and Kolhapur Districts.
