Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Activities – 2024-25

With the strategic objective of enhancing healthcare access and financial awareness among the rural communities, during the F.Y. 2024-25, the Company actively implemented CSR projects in the areas of rural empowerment and entrepreneurship, health care, education and ensuring environmental sustainability and ecological balance.

Rural empowerment and entrepreneurship:

Toyo-India contributed funds for the "Empowering women to enhance the quality of life in rural communities and foster entrepreneurship" project to uplift rural women in Kharivali Gram panchayat, located near our ILOBP Isambe Project site in the Raigad District of Maharashtra. The Program covered comprehensive training programs for entrepreneurship, including financial literacy, marketing, sustainable business practices and specialized training in incense stick making. This initiative aimed to generate income and promote entrepreneurship among rural women.

This Project also addressed the need for improved community infrastructure by distributing and installing dustbins to encourage cleanliness and better waste management within the community. Solar street lights (24 watts) were also installed, providing a sustainable source of light and safety for women and families in the village.

Health Care:

During the fiscal, the Company continued to allocate CSR funds to various Municipal Hospitals in Mumbai which specifically provides health care facilities at very concessional rates to poor and needy patients across India.

In line with the Prime Minister TB Eradication India Campaign, the Company contributed CSR Funds for providing nutritional support (food packets) to the poor and needy patients suffering from Tuberculosis (TB).

The Company contributed funds for procurement of Ambulance Van and other necessary equipments to provide quick medical help and transport in emergency situation and connect remote tribal communities to healthcare facilities and increase survival rates and improve health by ensuring fast medical help.

Education:

With the aim to provide quality education to children from socially or economically marginalized communities to realize their academic dreams, the Company provided funds for school infrastructure development project which includes providing improved classrooms, establishing Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) Education Centre. The Company also provided funds for Mini Solar Power Plant for a School in rural area and also allocated funds for carrying out flooring work of all the classrooms of the Government Sr. Sec. School which is located near our VGO-HDT project site at IOCL Refinery, Panipat.

To address the critical need for clean water, a drinking water system with a capacity of 4,000 litres per day was installed at the local school. This initiative not only improved the health and hygiene of students but also benefited the surrounding community by providing reliable access to safe drinking water.
